

## **INTRODUCTION**

### **1. ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY**

Manonmaniam Sundaranar University (MSU), named after the famous poet-laureate and scholar Professor P. Sundaram Pillai, was established on September 7, 1990 with the objective of catering to the long-felt needs of the three southern most districts of Tamil Nadu namely Tirunelveli, Tuticorin and Kanyakumari. The University has over 59 affiliated colleges, 4 Mano Colleges and 1 Constituent College. Many of these colleges have contributed significantly to the cause of higher education, of which three colleges including St. John's College, The M.D.T. Hindu College and Sarah Tucker College, the oldest women's college in the state, are over 100 years old.

### **LOCATION**

The University is situated at Abishekapatti, 9 Kms away from Tirunelveli Junction. A judicious blend of functional and aesthetic features distinguishes the campus buildings. The serene landscape and a vast campus of over 550 acres form an ideal setting for the academic community. The University, sensitive to the complex and diverse needs of the times, has evolved many innovative programmes. Research and extension activities are not pursued for its own sake, but are directed towards enriching the social matrix to help build better human beings and better tomorrow.

### **3. COLLABORATIVE VENTURES**

The University is actively engaged in collaborative ventures with individuals and institutions. The Centre for Environmental Sciences at Alwarkurichi, functioning in collaboration with the Amalgamations Group, bears testimony to this. Eco-friendly ventures in aquaculture, fishing and agro-inputs are its thrust areas. The Centre for Marine Science & Technology, Departments of Communication and Mass Media and Management Studies and Geo technology have made their mark in the respective field of study

### **4. CHOICE- BASED CREDIT SYSTEM**

Rapid changes have overtaken the world which now seems to resemble a global village. Information and knowledge, growing at a breathtaking speed, form the very crux of this changed scenario. Conventional disciplines and fields of study, thus far functioning as isolated compartments, have to address the challenges posed by these new changes. Further, students in pursuit of jobs in a competitive market are making ever new demands on the educational system. A University, which by definition, is situated at the frontiers of knowledge, needs to face such challenges squarely and MSU has responded by introducing Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS), which is practiced in many of the world's acclaimed Universities. MSU is the first in Tamil Nadu to implement it in a full – fledged manner.

In a pioneering move, the MSU is all set to demolish the disciplinary strait jackets. Under the CBCS, students from one department have the option to choose courses from other departments as well. Every PG programme will carry 72 credits of which 66 credits will be earned in the core discipline. For the remaining 06 credits, the students can choose supportive courses from other disciplines. In short, the students have a decisive say in deciding what to study and how to prepare themselves for a career.

With a strong committed team of nearly 100 qualified faculty members, the students of MSU have a clear edge over their counter parts elsewhere.

### **HOW DOES THE CBCS WORK?**

- I. 1. Total number of credits to be acquired for a P.G. Degree: 72 Credits.
2. Duration of the Course:
  - Normal Duration 4 Semesters
  - Maximum Duration 6 Semesters
3. Credits & Courses:
  - a) A candidate who successfully completes all the core courses, the project prescribed, the optional and supportive courses, and acquires not less than 72 credits and puts in the minimum of residence time will be eligible for receiving the degree.

b) One credit means one teaching period per week for one semester (16 weeks) for theory courses and one laboratory session of two periods / week for one semester. One teaching period is of 60 minutes duration.

Courses are divided into 3 categories

1. Core courses are subjects on which a student admitted to a particular programme of study is to do compulsorily. Total credits for Core Courses are 48.
2. Elective courses may be chosen by the student from the optionals offered by the department. The Departments are expected to offer as many optional courses as possible. Total credits for Elective Courses are 12.
3. Supportive courses are to be taken from other disciplines. Total credits for Supportive Courses are 6.

**II.** In all P.G. programmes a 6 credit project is a must.

**III.** In the choice of Elective and Supportive Courses, the student will be guided by the faculty advisor / Head of the Department.

**IV.** In general, the Supportive Courses of 3 credits will be offered in the second and third semesters.

## **5. LIBRARY**

The University Library is well equipped and has a good collection of reference works, books and journals. It has its membership with DELNET and also providing e-journals service through INFONET. Internet Facility with Online Public Access Cataloguing Service is provided to the users. The Library has been fully automated with the help of INFLIBNET Centre, Ahmedabad. There are shelves containing books gifted by American Information Resource Centre, Chennai.

## **6. COMPUTER CENTRE**

All the Science Departments have a Computer laboratories of their own. Students of arts and science departments are permitted to use the common Internet Centre available in the campus.

## **7. UNIVERSITY HOSTEL**

Hostel facility is available for women students. Foundation stone has been laid for the Hostel of men students.

## **8. MODE OF MAKING APPLICATION**

1. The application for admission should be made in the prescribed form issued by the University. The application form can be had from the Registrar, Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli – 627 012 on payment of Rs.300/- (Rupees Three hundred only) in the form of a Demand Draft from any Nationalized Bank drawn in favour of the Registrar, Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli, payable at Tirunelveli. (SC/ST candidates are given one application at free of cost producing an attested photocopy of the Community Certificate).

2. The application form should be filled in by the candidate in his / her own handwriting.
3. The candidate must sign over the photo and get it attested by a gazetted officer.
4. The attested copies of the following certificates should be enclosed with the application form.
  - a. Degree Mark statements (up to V Semester, if the candidate is awaiting final Semester result).
  - b. Degree Provisional Certificate / Diploma (for those who are awaiting results, a course certificate from the Principal is needed).
  - c. Community Certificate (for SC/ST/BC/MBC/DNC candidates only)
  - d. Sports Certificates (if the candidate is an outstanding sports person).
  - e. NSS Certificate (if the candidate is the best NSS Volunteer).
  - f. Physically Handicapped Certificate (if the candidate is Physically Challenged)
5. Filled in original application forms along with the attested xerox copies of the above Certificates should be sent to the Head of the Department of the course concerned. Xerox Copy of the original application form along with attested Xerox copies of the above certificates should be sent to the Registrar, Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Abishekapatti, Tirunelveli – 627 012.
6. **A Demand draft for Rs.150/- towards fee for Entrance Test, drawn in favour of the Registrar, Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, payable at Tirunelveli from a Nationalised Bank** should accompany the original application form (Except MBA, MCA & ME candidates)
7. Any change in the address of the applicant should be intimated immediately to the Registrar and to the Head of the Department concerned.
8. In all communications to the Registrar and to the Head of the Department the application number should be mentioned.
9. A stamp size photo has to be submitted to the HOD concerned at the time of admission for the preparation of ID card.

**9. ADMISSION PROCEDURE (Except for AICTE Approved Courses)**

- a. Admission will be based on the qualifying examination (50%) and the entrance test to be conducted by the University (50%).
- b. For the computation of qualifying examination marks, the first 5 Semesters will be taken into account for the candidates awaiting final Semester results. Candidates with one arrear paper will also be allowed to take the entrance exam on condition that the marks secured in the failed paper will be taken into account.

c. However, when a student fails to satisfy the eligibility criteria after the publication of final Semester results he/she is automatically dropped out of the course without any claim over the fee remitted. The fee remitted once will not be refunded.

#### **10. ADDITIONAL DETAILS**

1. Admission to a course will be made on the basis of merit, subject to the rules of communal reservation. Academic record relating to part III and performance in the entrance test will be taken into account. Date and venue of entrance test will be intimated individually to the candidates.

2. The rules of reservation of seats prescribed by the Government of Tamil Nadu, 18% for SC, 1% for ST, 30% for BC, 20% for MBC and Denotified Communities and 31% for Open Competition will be followed in admission to each course. Among the total number of seats in the University Departments, 2% will be reserved for outstanding sports persons and 3% for Physically Handicapped. Eligibility for sports quota is as per the norms stipulated in G.O. MS. No. 466 Education, Science and Technology (YI) Department dated 8 June 1994 Physically Handicapped Candidates are exempted from Payment of Tuition Fee.

3. Candidates selected for admission will be intimated individually by post. The University is not responsible for any delay or loss of this communication in postal transit.

4. The selected candidate should submit the following certificates in original at the time of admission.(i). Degree Mark Statement

(ii). Degree Provisional Certificate / Original Degree or Diploma. The candidates awaiting the results need to submit mark statements up to V Semester and the Course Certificate from the Principal.

(iii). S.S.L.C

(iv). Transfer Certificate

(v). Community Certificate

(vi). Conduct Certificate

5. The University reserves the right to suspend the conduct of any course if the circumstances so warrant.

#### **11. ENTRANCE TEST**

The Entrance Test will be objective type with multiple choice questions. The venue and date of entrance test will be informed by post.

## 12. RAGGING IN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS:

If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student will be given an opportunity to explain his or her conduct and if his or her explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority will expel him or her from the Institutions.

## 13. DETAILS ABOUT FEE

1. The candidates admitted shall pay the tuition and other fees as specified in the admission letter.
2. The fees must be remitted through a nationalized bank by Demand Draft drawn in favour of The Registrar, Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, payable at Tirunelveli.
3. The odd semester (First Year and Second Year) fees should be paid at the time of admission / before 31<sup>st</sup> July and the even semester fees within 15 days of the commencement of second semester.
4. In accordance with G.O.Ms.No.722 Social Welfare Department dated 13<sup>th</sup> October 1977, SC/ST and SC/ST converted Christians are exempted from the payment of tuition fee and exemption will be granted only upon the production of Community Certificate (in original). The exemption does not cover other fees, namely, special fee, laboratory fee, guidance & counseling fee and contingency fee. This means SC/ST and SC/ST converted Christian students should pay these fees. In addition to Tuition Fee, Special Fee, Lab Fee and Contingency Fee, the following fees also have to be paid at the time of admission.

**Note: SC/ST students of the regular courses need not pay Tuition Fee.**

Students who are graduates from other Universities should pay the following fee:

- (i) Eligibility Fee (Rs.200 for Indian Universities Graduates Rs.500 for Foreign University Graduates).
- (ii) Fee for Recognition Rs.100 and
- (iii) Fee for Entrance Test Rs.100. These fee must be paid in the first semester by a separate Demand Draft drawn on any Nationalized Bank in favour of the Registrar, Manonmaniam Sundaranar University payable at Tirunelveli.

### **Instructions for A.I.C.T.E. Approved Courses**

Applicants seeking admission to M.B.A., M.C.A., and M.E. (Computer Science & Engineering), Courses are required to appear for the Tamil Nadu Common Entrance Test (TANCET) to be conducted by Anna University, Chennai.

1. Selection for the M.B.A. programme is based on the TANCET Entrance Marks, Group Discussion and Personal Interview.
2. Selection for the M.C.A. and M.E. programmes will be made based on the TANCET entrance test marks. GATE candidates will be admitted directly to M.E. programme based on their GATE score.
3. All the GATE candidates are eligible for AICTE PG Scholarship.

### **Procedure to Apply:**

1. To take the Tamil Nadu Common Entrance Test 2007 (TANCET) conducted by Anna University, Chennai.
2. To send application to Manonmaniam Sundaranar University separately for admission to M.B.A., M.C.A., & M.E. (Computer Science & Engineering). Application forms can either be downloaded from [www.msuniversity.org.in](http://www.msuniversity.org.in) or obtained from the Registrar by remitting a Crossed Demand Draft drawn in favour of **‘The Registrar, Manonmaniam Sundaranar University’, payable at ‘Tirunelveli’,** for Rs.300/- in person or Rs.320/- by Post.
3. Applications downloaded from the website must be submitted along with a Crossed Demand Draft drawn in favour of **‘The Registrar, M.S. University’, payable at ‘Tirunelveli’,** for Rs. 300/-
4. The SC/ ST candidates should produce attested Photo copy of the community certificate along with the requisition letter to obtain application form at free of cost.

## 14. STUDENT EVALUATION

1. For both full-time and part-time Courses, syllabus and scheme of examination are the same.

Choice Based Credit System is followed for all the Courses.

2. Evaluation is based on continuous internal assessment (25%) and end-semester examination (75%). The Candidates have to score a minimum of 40% in internal, minimum of 50% in the end semester examinations and 50% total in each Theory Paper. For Practicals the internal : external marks is 40 : 60.

3. The University Examination will be held in November/ December in the odd semester and in April / May in the even semester.

4. A student can be admitted to an examination only upon the submission of the prescribed application form on or before the prescribed date and the application form should be accompanied by a demand draft for the prescribed examination fee drawn on any nationalized bank in favour of The Registrar, Manonmaniam Sundaranar University payable at Tirunelveli. A minimum of 75% attendance is required to appear for the University Examinations.

5. A minimum of 75% attendance is required to appear for the University Examinations.

6. Students may apply for paper-wise appearance in an examination. But they should register for all papers in the first appearance in each semester.

7. Successful candidates in the final examination will be classified as follows:

60% and above : I Class

50% and above, but below

60% of aggregate marks : II Class

8. When a student completes the required 72 credits prescribed for the course, Overall Percentage of Marks (OPM) will be calculated as follows. The marks obtained by the candidate (sum of external and internal marks) in a paper multiplied by the credits assigned to the paper. Such weighted marks for all the papers are added and divided by the total credits (minimum 72).

9. There is provision for revaluation.
